

# Are your children eligible for Free School Meals?

## Please check here:

Are you in receipt of one or more of the following?

- Income Support
- Income-Based Jobseekers Allowance
- Employment and Support Allowance (Income Related)
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Families in receipt of Child Tax Credit will also qualify provided that (a) they are NOT also entitled to Working Tax Credit and (b) their annual income, as assessed by Her Majesty's Revenue and Customs, does not exceed £16,190 (as at 6 April 2009, subject to annual review)
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit

If so, all you have to do is fill in the form [Application for Free School Meals](#) and return it to Mrs Clarke, Student Support, Henry Beaufort School.

There are a number of other benefits that come with claiming a free school meals allowance.

- Financial support for school trips.
- Ensuring your child is supported financially so that they can take part in the Enrichment Week activity they really want to do.
- Helping your child by providing a personalised pathway that will support their learning.
- Family workshop opportunities including cooking, carpentry and sporting programmes.
