INTRODUCTION

Welcome to our Enrichment Week booklet. Activities during this week will be organised by year group – this booklet introduces the choices for Year 9. One of the main aims of Enrichment Week is for students to have the opportunity to experience new challenges and situations in the company of students they may not know. I hope that we have arranged an exciting range of choices for students in Year 9.

We will endeavour to give as many students as possible their first choice activity, but there will always be some who cannot have their first choice. Please make sure that second and third choices are carefully considered.

All activities will require a minimum number of 700 stamps to have been collected by the end of the Spring term on Thursday 29th March 2018.

As soon as you have collected 700 stamps you may go and see Mrs Campbell in the Finance/Admin Office to get priority choice of activities!

Note: If you have any outstanding payments owing to The Henry Beaufort School from previous school activities (eg peripatetic music, day trips) these must be settled prior to acceptance on other school activities/Enrichment Week.

In the past some students have not signed up for anything until the last minute, making the organisation of groupings very difficult. Students who do not wish to participate in an activity will need to attend school during the week and lessons will be organised for them. Please be aware of the way in which we will treat absence from school during this week (see Attendance page).

It is most important at this stage that students and parents recognise the commitment made upon agreeing to join a trip or activity. The loss of even one student to a small trip can jeopardise its viability. A non-returnable deposit will be required for most activities.

We are able to offer some financial assistance for students who receive free school meals, please contact the activity leader for that trip if you would like some advice about this.

DANCE

COST: £15

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 16

ACTIVITY LEADER: Mrs Brisbane

DIGITAL PHOTOGRAPHY

COST: £50

ACTIVITY LEADER: Miss Shelton

Join us for an opportunity to build your photography skills at a range of locations around Hampshire and Dorset.

We will be visiting venues that allow you to hone your skills in photographing architecture, wildlife, people, and landscapes. Having your own camera is essential and some basic knowledge of photography would be advisable.



FILM MAKING

COST: £0

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 10

ACTIVITY LEADER: Ms Herbert

This is an onsite activity where we will explore the fundamentals of film making, from script to screen. We will use a range of skills, from storyboarding, to filming, to editing and completing a short film by the end of the week.



GOLF

COST: £180 approx.

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 8 Year 9s and 8 Year 7s

ACTIVITY LEADER: Mr Applin

At South Winchester Golf Club. Each day we will have some time on the driving range with PGA professional support. Then take to the course for some different holes each day. Lunch in the clubhouse with basket meals provided. Then finish with some chipping, putting or bunker practice each afternoon. The end of the week will have prizes for most improved golfer!

HARRY POTTER STUDIOS/MEDIA



COST: £50

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 25

ACTIVITY LEADER: Mrs Seddon

Would you like to learn what goes in to making a film? With a visit to the Harry Potter studios for inspiration, you can film and edit your own short Movie. Whether you are fan of Horror, Action or Romance you will learn the tricks of the trade to create your own film. One day will be spent learning how to cast spells, visiting the Hogwarts Express and drinking butterbeer, the rest of the week will be taken up with filming and editing a short film of your choosing, whether this be live action or animation. All you need is an idea!



SANDBANKS WATER SPORTS

COST: £230

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 50

ACTIVITY LEADER: Mr Janes

Spend the week on the water with The Watersports Academy, Sandbanks, Poole.

This will consist of three days of windsurfing and sailing, one day of kayaking over to Brownsea Island and on the final day a treasure hunt on an eight meter RIB (a rigid inflatable boat) in and around Poole harbour. All activities will be run by fully qualified instructors. This is a non-residential trip and we will depart from The Henry Beaufort School every morning by bus.

SPORTS/PAINTBALL/GO KARTING



COST: £90

Five days of adventure and excitement in and out of school.

We will be going paintballing and go karting for two of the days and trying out a large range of sporting activities on the other days. If you are feeling competitive, energetic and ready for a challenge then come and join the fun.

BERLIN

COST: £575 approx.

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 30

ACTIVITY LEADER: Mrs Taggart

This trip leaves by coach on Sunday. It is a six day trip with four nights spent in a central Berlin hotel in twin rooms, all meals and visits are included. We will arrive back in Winchester very early on Saturday morning. If you would like to raise your cultural awareness, improve your language skills and visit historical places this trip is for you. You will have an amazing time.

Planned activities will include: A boat tour of Berlin on the River Spree, a tour of Berlin to include visits to the Reichstag, Brandenburg Gate, Checkpoint Charlie, The German Holocaust Memorial and Potsdamer Platz.

We will visit Sachsenhausen concentration camp as well as a visit to the Jewish Museum. A trip to Ku'dam for the best shopping in Berlin and a visit to Berlin Zoo are also included. Evening activities will include bowling and a trip up the TV Tower and Alexanderplatz.

ROME

COST: £590 approx.

Rome loves its ancient reputation as the capital of the world, and rightfully so. Come to Rome with us – trips around the ancient city, looking inside the Coliseum, trips to the Vatican and the wonderful Pantheon.

Rome is an open-air museum, the city has an ever-growing list of spectacular archaeological sites and monuments, gilded churches filled with paintings by Italy's top master artists, exquisitely sculpted fountains and beautifully manicured public parks. We will be walking in the sunshine every day!

We will be staying in the centre of Rome—all food is included in the price, breakfast, a pack lunch and dinner al fresco! Four days of walking and wonder – we will be 'talking Italian like Robert De Niro' as Bananarama say! Ask you parents about them if you need to!
