Adverse Weather Conditions

As you will be aware there have been reports of the potential for snow fall and icy conditions on Tuesday evening through to Wednesday morning. We are monitoring this situation.

We would like students to make their way home promptly tonight. Home Learning club will close at 3.45 today.

In situations of potentially disruptive snowfall the schools Health & Safety Officer assesses the school site early in the morning to determine whether it is viable to open the school.

In the event of a school closure or a delayed start in order to make the site safe, details will be published on the school's website and a Parentmail will be sent out. You can also view all school closures on the Hampshire County Council website:

We would aim to communicate this information to you before your child has to leave for school. This includes those students who travel to school by bus. Bus companies will be contacted and informed. A number of buses travel some distance to reach the school and it may be the case that adverse weather conditions in areas outside of Winchester would make travel difficult. In such a case the bus company will contact the school and we will alert you to this situation.

In the eventuality that we have to make the decision to close the school early because of significant snowfall during the day we will contact you to inform you once we know the situation with buses.
