

For prospective parents:

The Learning Resource Centre (LRC) is a much loved, inviting area of the school and is located at the heart of the Henry Beaufort School in the Winchester building. The LRC is an exciting vibrant space with an adaptable use for a wide range of activities such as; teaching classes, reading for pleasure, Home Learning Club and Book Clubs.



We make sure to stock the library with the latest books and texts, both fiction and non-fiction, which cover a wide range of topics and genres.

Students in Year 7 and 8 have fortnightly library lessons, in which they can make the most of the library resources and become familiar with the library, as well as have time to enjoy reading and literature.

Students in Year 7 and 8 will be encouraged to keep a Reading Journal to keep a record of the books they have read. Students will be given time in a Library lesson to debate, discuss and write a critical review about their book. The Reading Journal will become a valuable tool to monitor their reading when transitioning from Year 6 to 7 and to log different authors and genres.

Home Learning Club

The Home Learning Club provides an environment for students to complete their Home Learning to the best of their ability. Home Learning Club runs after school in the LRC between 2.40-4.00pm on Monday to Thursday and 2.40-3.30pm on a Friday. Home Learning Club allows students to work on their Home Learning with access to all of the library facilities, including books, laptops, computers and stationery.



There is no need to book in advance for Home Learning Club and it is open to all years.
