Year 7 Information for Parents

I hope that you and your families are keeping safe and well.

I am aware that you have had a reduced number of opportunities this year to receive information about your child's progress as we have been unable to have our usual Progress Evening for parents. I know that you all understand the reasons for this but I wanted to explain what we are doing to support your child at present and then how we will report to you about their progress next year.

Your child is completing assessments as part of their online work. Mr Naisbitt, Head of Year 7, is collating this information and will be following up with positive postcards to those students that are completing all of their work to the required standard and will contact parents individually where there are concerns.

In September when your child starts Year 8 we will report to you on three separate occasions with their progress, attitude and home learning grades. You will receive these reports in November, March and June. The Year 8 progress evening is scheduled for January 2021. Exact dates will be available later this term when the school calendar is published on the website.
