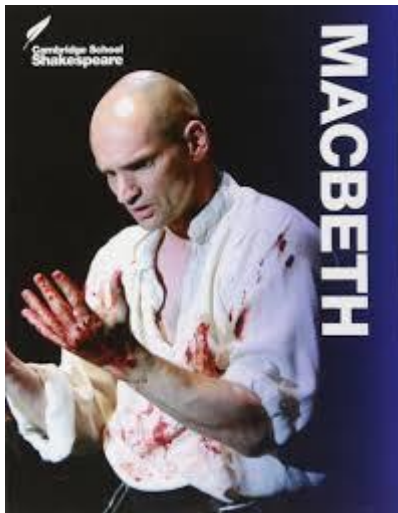
Dear Parent,

Year 10 GCSE Shakespeare text: Macbeth

Later this term your child will be returning to their study of 'Macbeth'. Students studied 'Macbeth' during the 'Work from Home' period in the summer term, therefore it is really important that we return to it to ensure all students have a confident understanding of the play. This is the last of the three literature texts that your child will be studying for GCSE, having already studied William Golding's 'Lord of the Flies' (the modern text) in the Year 9 spring term (before the 'Work from Home' period) and Stevenson's 'Jekyll and Hyde' (19th century text) this term.

Please could I ask that you look to purchase a copy of 'Macbeth' (if you have not already done so after the Schoolcomms in April) so that your child is prepared for their lessons later this term. Please could you ensure students have a copy of this by the 30th November.

We are unable to sell copies of these texts on the school website so they will need to be purchased from a website such as Amazon. If possible, the '**Cambridge University press**' edition of Macbeth, pictured below:
