Throughout your child's first year here at The Henry Beaufort School they will get the opportunity to attend a variety of enriching extracurricular activities.

Sports provision takes place from Monday to Thursday with a wide range of individual and team games. We provide both friendly and competitive opportunities that are available to all. We are an active member of the Eastleigh and Winchester District Schools competitions, so students will get plenty of opportunities to compete against other local schools in most of Sports Clubs. In Sports such as Football, Dance and Handball we have also competed on a County and National level.

Within the Performing Arts department there are opportunities for students to work with professional musicians, dramatists and artists, to further develop their understanding and progress in these areas. The school holds the Gold Arts Mark Award.
