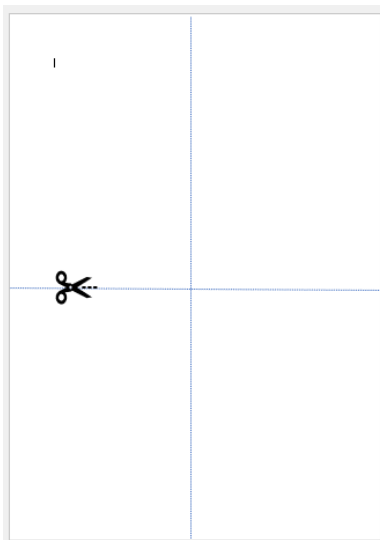


Subject: Business Studies

Task 4: Revision Flashcards.

For this task you will need some A4 paper plain or coloured, which you fold in half widthways and lengthways to make an A6 sized card. You can then cut along the folded lines to make an A6 card (see below).

Now you will need to fill one side of the card with the key concept and then the other side with the definition. The one shown below is an example of a 'Entrepreneur' and 'Social Enterprise'. Hold the in front of you with the key concept on and see if you can guess then definition and vice-versa



Entrepreneur	An Entrepreneur is someone who is willing t take the risks involved in starting a business. Entrepreneurs believe that rewards of starting a business are worth the risks and costs involved.
Social Enterprise	A Social Enterprise is a business that is set up to help society rather than to make a profit.
