



Top Tips for learning an MFL

1)Regular practice (Spaced practice) reflective



· Going over your work little and often. Spread your learning out - do a little bit everyday, or every other day.

2) Going over previous work





(Interleaving)

· Going over your class notes and knowledge of previous topics. Use resources to help fill in the gaps of knowledge

3) Presenting your knowledge without any help.

(Retrieval practice)







· Write down everything you know about a topic Use resources to test yourself before the real test.
