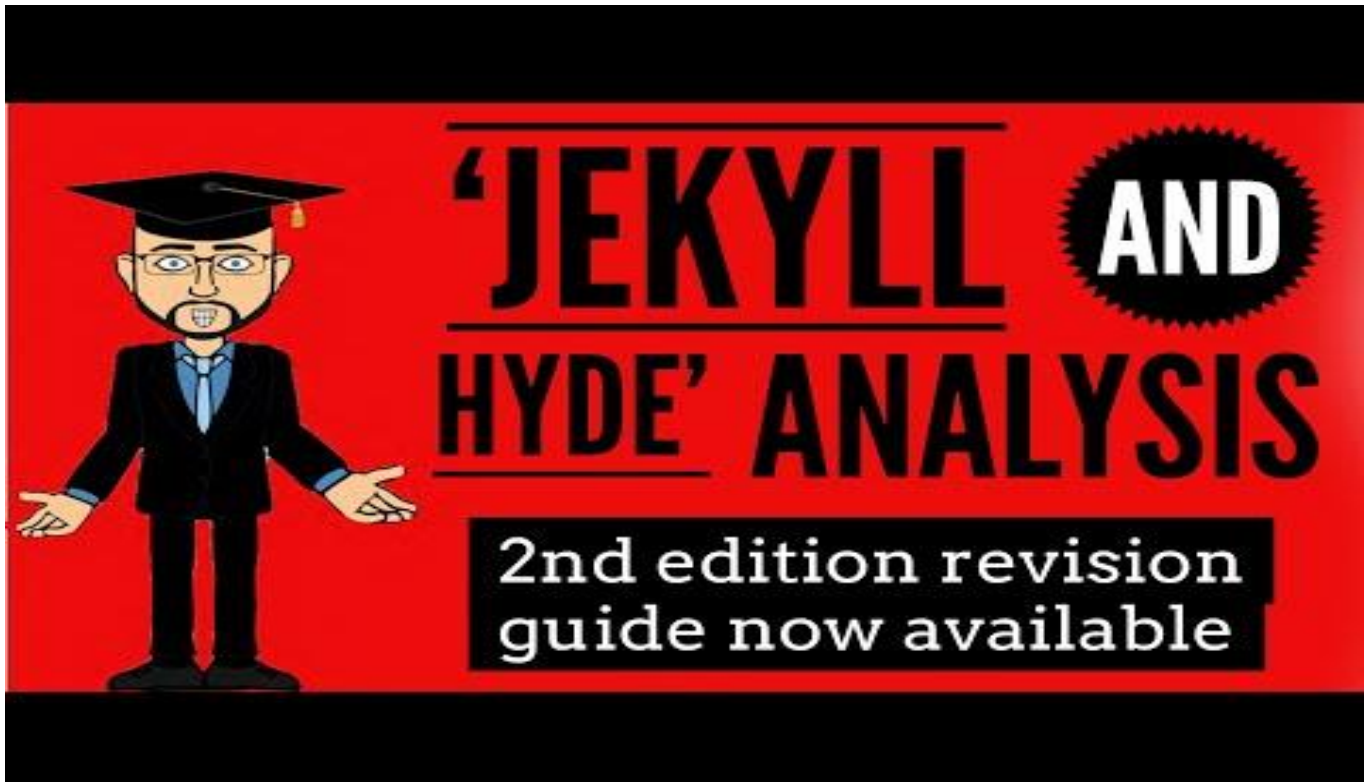

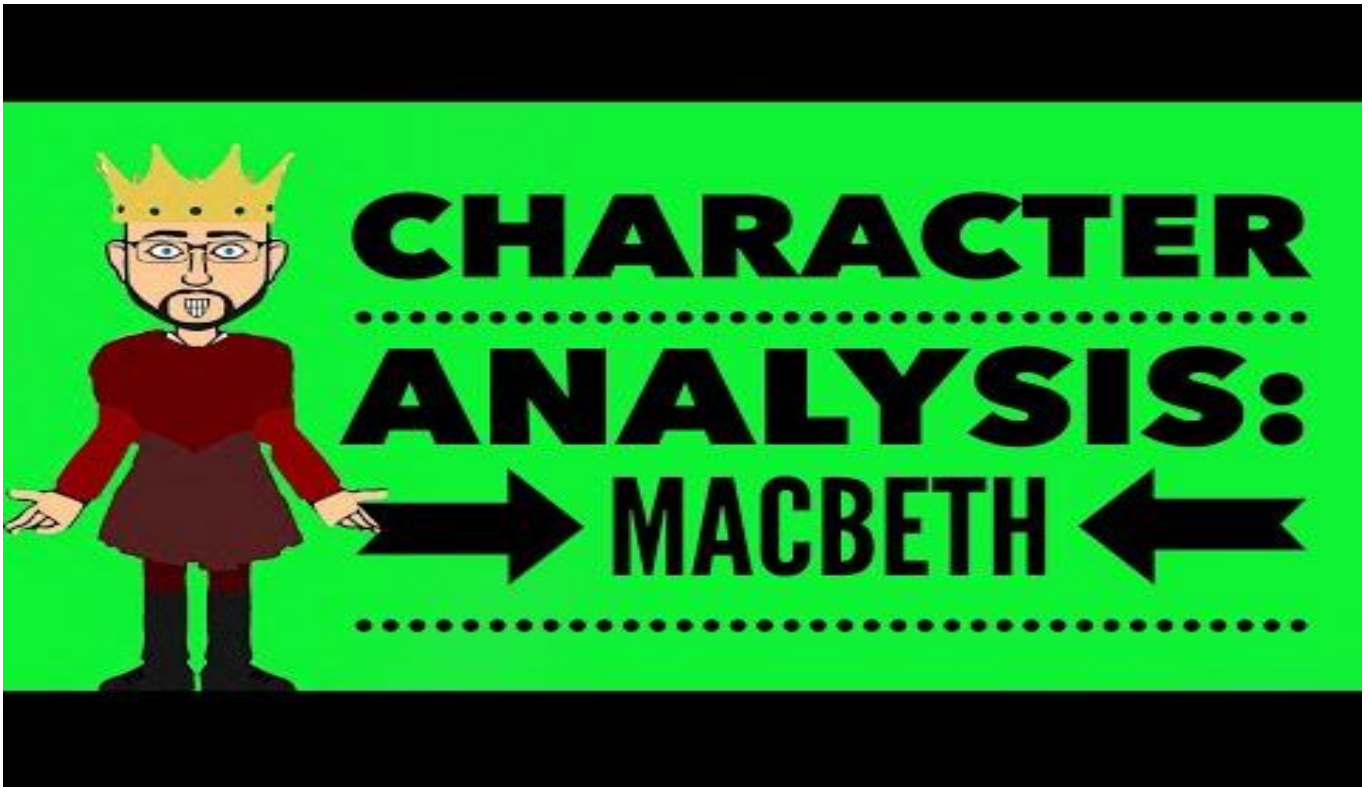
Task 5: Mr Bruff Videos and Note-Taking
