FEATHERS AND FUR

COST: £65

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 15

Students will get the opportunity to experience and enjoy a week based around the following activities:

- Alpaca feeding and walk
- Hawk Conservancy
- Farm visit
- Zoo
- Sloth experience



UNDERWATER ART

COST: £60

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 20

Students will spend a highly creative and enjoyable week creating 3D and 2D Art work using exciting art materials and techniques which they don't usually get their hands on.

All creations produced will be inspired by creatures of the deep. Students will experiment and create with materials such as wire construction, modroc, clay, specialist paints and textiles techniques.

Includes a day out to Bournemouth Oceanarium.

SPORTS WEEK

COST: £100

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 30

If you enjoy sport, this is the week for you!

Students will be spending an active week taking part in sporting activities on the school site but also exploring new and exciting sport activities in the local area including trips out to a water park, bowling and Lazer Quest. A day at Calshot taking part in activities such as skiing, ringos, climbing, aero trek and archery.





LEGO ANIMATION

COST: £65

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 20-30

Join us for an opportunity to be creative making your own Lego animation movie.

We shall be taking a trip to Legoland, Windsor, where we will attend a Lego Animation Workshop and enjoy the park creations. Then in school we shall construct our own set, making a Lego animated movie and watching it on our final day.

SAINTS COACHING ON ASTRO

COST: £85

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 20-30

This is a full week of football! Professional coaches from the Saints Foundation will be delivering 5 days of skills, tactics and training to help you to improve your footballing ability every morning. There will be matches and competitions all the way through, as well as end of week awards. Every day focuses on a different skill, from dribbling to shooting and passing to tackling. It's based on the 3G pitch at the school, so it will be a great experience, whatever the weather! Depending on availability we will also visit Saints Stadium for a tour.



SANDBANKS WATER SPORTS

COST: £250

NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 100

Spend the week on the water with The Watersports Academy, Sandbanks, Poole. This will consist of 5 days of windsurfing and sailing, kayaking, paddle boarding and a trip on a boat to view local sites. All activities will be run by fully qualified instructors.
