[Medicine Work Experience Week In London](#) - February 12th - 18th 2023. 1 week in person course including accommodation, meals and teacher supervision. Students visit different hospitals in London for work experience.

[Virtual Medicine Work Experience Week](#) - February 20th - 24th 2023. 1 week online course where hundreds of students take part, gaining work experience through different activities each day, hosted by our team of practising UK NHS doctors.

[Online Radiology Work Experience](#) - Saturday March 4th 2023 - Another free session we are running for all budding medics. Interactive day where students can get involved in diagnosing patients with our NHS doctors. Simply join through the link, we've 1,500 places available.

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National Horseracing College

In just 12-weeks, the National Horseracing College, based near Doncaster, South Yorkshire ensures students have the equine skills, practical knowledge and experience to be employed as a racing groom. Upon successful completion of the initial 12-weeks training, students are secured a six-week work placement in a racing stable. This placement can be in whatever part of the UK the student desires. Upon successful completion of the work placement, students will be secured employment as a racing groom in yards the length and breadth of the country, where they will commence a Level 2 Apprenticeship in Racehorse Care. The apprenticeship is completed at their place of work with a member of our Roving Tutor team visiting every four-weeks.

Our 12-week, residential Foundation Course is the starting point and the cost for training, accommodation and meals for 12-weeks is £500.00. Bursaries are available. Absolutely no experience with horses or academic qualifications are required. Young people can commence the Foundation Course any time after they have completed Year 11. There is no upper age limit. Open Mornings, including virtual events, are held each month.
