GCSE Results 2024

The Henry Beaufort School are celebrating an outstanding set of results for a wonderful group of young people. These positive outcomes are their passport to higher and further education.

Students who attended our school have delivered superb headlines in all subject areas.

Subject/ Grade	4 or better	5 or better	7 or better
English	88%	78%	38%
Maths	85%	66%	21%
Students achieving both English and maths	81%	60%	19%

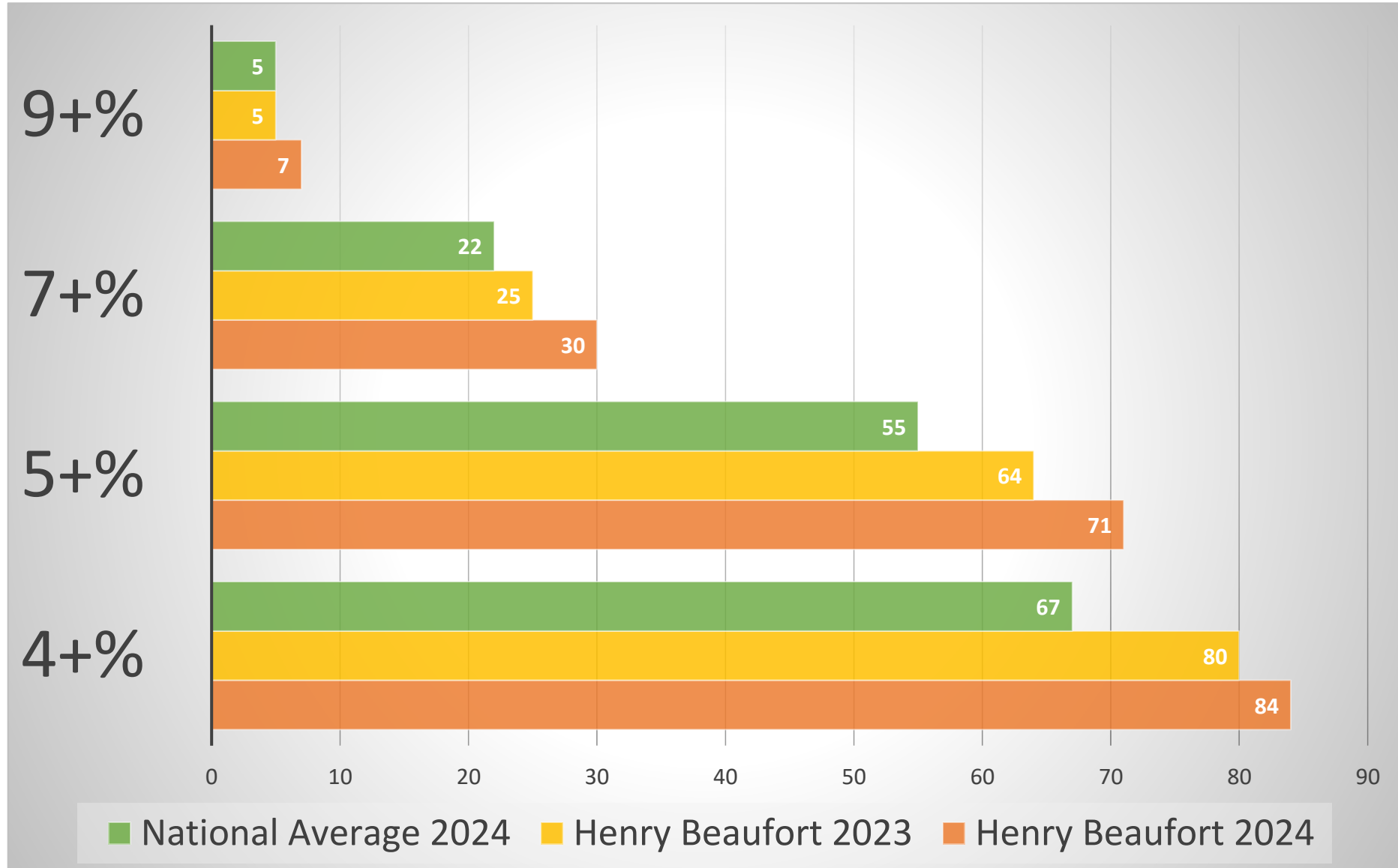
In science 82% of students attained two grade 4s or above and 88% at least one grade 4 or above.

30% of all the results were at grade 7 or better.

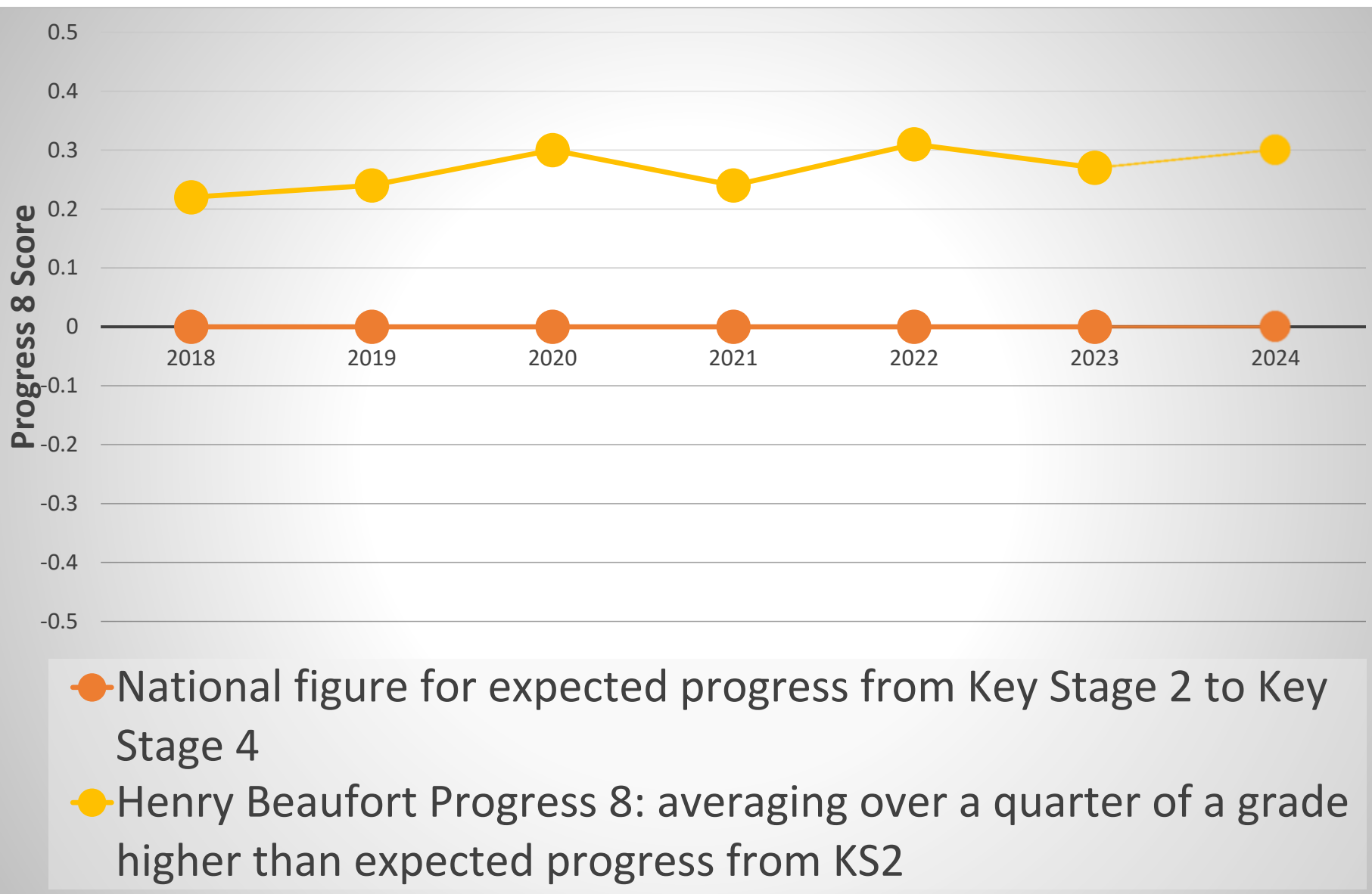
Other subjects of note for the percentage of students attaining a grade 5 or above:

- In total approximately 6 hours a week

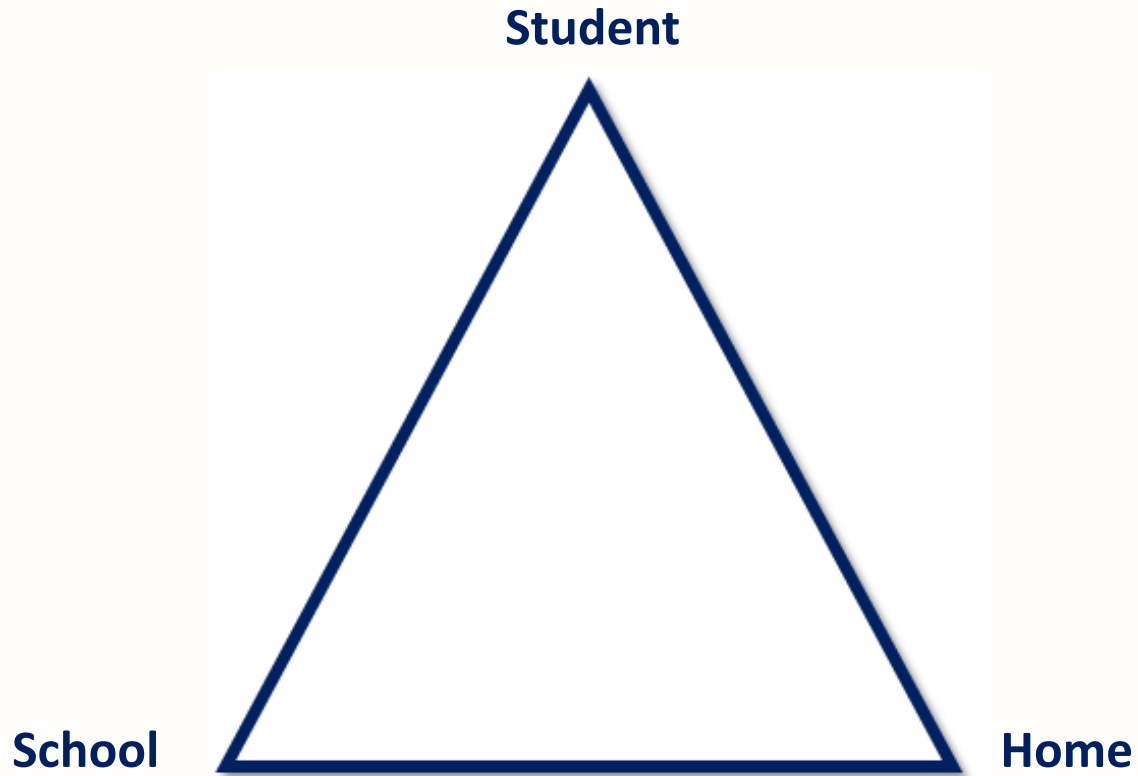

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

What students need to know and do?

Daily:

- Collect your stamps
- Attend school and lessons every day
- Follow our basic standards of the 5 golden rules

Year 11:

- Collect 650 by Friday 4th April 2025 to receive your 'Leaver's Invitation'.
- Maintain at least 95% attendance (unless medically authorised).
- Complete all NEAs and coursework.
- Have no suspensions since Monday 6th January 2025.
- Avoid patterns of lateness or truancy, including tutor times.

After Exams:

- Complete an exit form confirming you have returned all library books, your locker key, have no outstanding fees. This form will be exchanged for your Leaver's Ball ticket.

What happens if I do not meet the criteria?

- After Easter, you will be given a Leaver's Passport to complete.
- Each of your teachers will provide a stamp to confirm that you are:
 - Working hard in lessons
 - Wearing the correct uniform
 - Arriving on time
 - Attending clinics
 - Completing home learning and revision
- You need every teacher to stamp your passport to ensure you can attend the Leaver's Ball.
- The completed passport will earn you the Leaver's invitation.

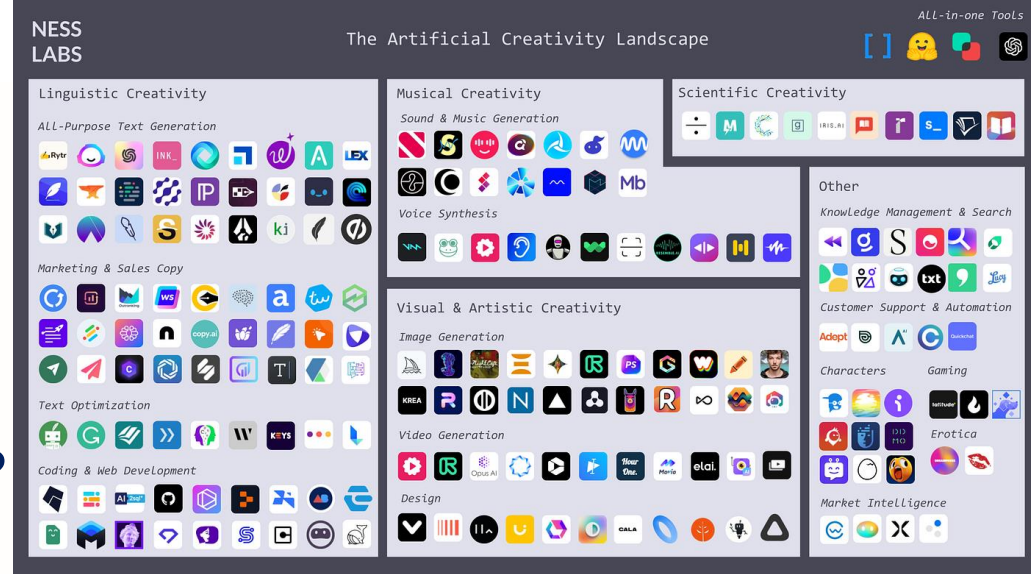
Non-Examined Assessments

- Often project based
- Demonstrate additional skills
- Marked by class teacher and moderated by exam board
- Students OWN work – no additional assistance or AI software
