Independent Bus Service

The Henry Beaufort School runs independent bus services to Andover, Basingstoke and Stockbridge, all students coming from these areas will be **guaranteed** a place on one of the buses.

Late Buses

The School operates a late bus service transporting students across ALL routes, both in catchment and the surrounding area, these late services run for all students at 4:10pm. on Mondays, Wednesdays and Thursdays for students wishing to make use of the after-school clubs. Late bus users must collect a stamp in their planner before they can board the bus.

Please Note:- Return Journeys will be determined by the number of students wishing to travel, this means that <u>students may not be travelling on their allocated route home.</u> <u>Bus</u> routes are often combined to ensure the quickest and most logical route to each destination.

Late bus users need a stamp in their planner before they can board the bus.

Students who normally catch the Hampshire County Council funded buses will be subject to a small charge of £1 for the late bus service.
