STUDENT FUND

As you will be aware government funding for schools has been reducing in real terms across a number of years making it increasingly necessary for schools to seek alternative sources of income. At The Henry Beaufort School this has been managed through an increase in community lettings and applications for funding for projects such as the sanctuary garden.

Robust financial management monitored and evaluated by the governing body of the school has allowed the school to offer:

- A broad and balanced curriculum for our students based on the academic profile of each year group
- A wide range of sporting, cultural and extracurricular activities which is a strength of the school and allows all students to maximise their potential outside of the classroom.

HOW YOU CAN HELP
