Welcome to our Enrichment Week Booklet. Activities during this week will be organised by year group - this booklet introduces the choices for Years 8 and 9. One of the main aims of Enrichment Week is for students to have the opportunity to experience new challenges and situations in the company of students they may not know. We have arranged an exciting range of choices for students in Years 8 and 9.

#### Introduction

We will endeavour to give as many students as possible their first-choice activity, but there will always be some who cannot have their first choice. Please make sure that second and third choices are carefully considered.

It is most important at this stage that students and parents recognise the commitment made upon agreeing to join a trip or activity. The loss of even one student to a small trip can jeopardise its viability. A **non-returnable deposit** will be required for ALL activities. If we do not get enough contributions to cover the cost of the trip in full or enough students to go for the trip, we may need to consider cancelling it.

We offer a range of activities to suit a variety of budgets and interests. Please note the cost of the trip when selecting an Enrichment week activity as some trips may have expenses that <u>must</u> be paid for including accommodation for residential trips. If selecting a residential trip, please take into consideration any other residential trips your child is already committed to attending.

#### How to use this Booklet

- 1. Please read the entire booklet carefully and discuss the options with your parents. Some of the prices given are approximate and will be confirmed. Payment schedules will be released thereafter.
- 2. You should indicate **three choices in order of preference** via the <u>Microsoft Form</u> (more information can be found on the back page of this booklet). Remember it may not be possible to allocate all students to their first choice, so equal thought should be given to second and third choices.
- 3. Make sure the form has been submitted by Friday 7th November 2025
- 4. We will confirm your child's allocation and we will be asking for deposits to be paid by **Friday 12**<sup>th</sup> **December**

COST: £75

**NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 15**

**COST: £140**

Students will be spending an active week taking part in sporting activities on the school site but also exploring new and exciting sport activities in the local area including trips out to a water park, bowling and Lazer Quest. A day at Calshot taking part in activities such skiing, ringos, climbing, aero trek and archery and a day playing golf!

## SAINTS COACHING ON ASTRO

COST: £90

**NUMBER OF STUDENTS: 30** 

This is a full week of football! Professional coaches from the Saints Foundation will be delivering 4 days of skills, tactics

and training to help you to improve your footballing ability every morning. There will be matches and competitions all the way through, as well as end of week awards. Every day focuses on a different skill, from dribbling to shooting and passing to tackling. It's based on the 3G pitch at the school, so it will be a great experience, whatever the weather! On Friday we head to Saints, for a stadium tour, presentation of medals and lunch at the Dell Pub.

# MAGICAL WORLDS AND MAGICAL WORDS




COST: £175


# PGL Liddington (Year 8)

TRAVEL: Coach and Ferry. The outward and return journeys will be overnight.


