I will go to a classroom in my group. We will talk about what it is like at Henry Beaufort

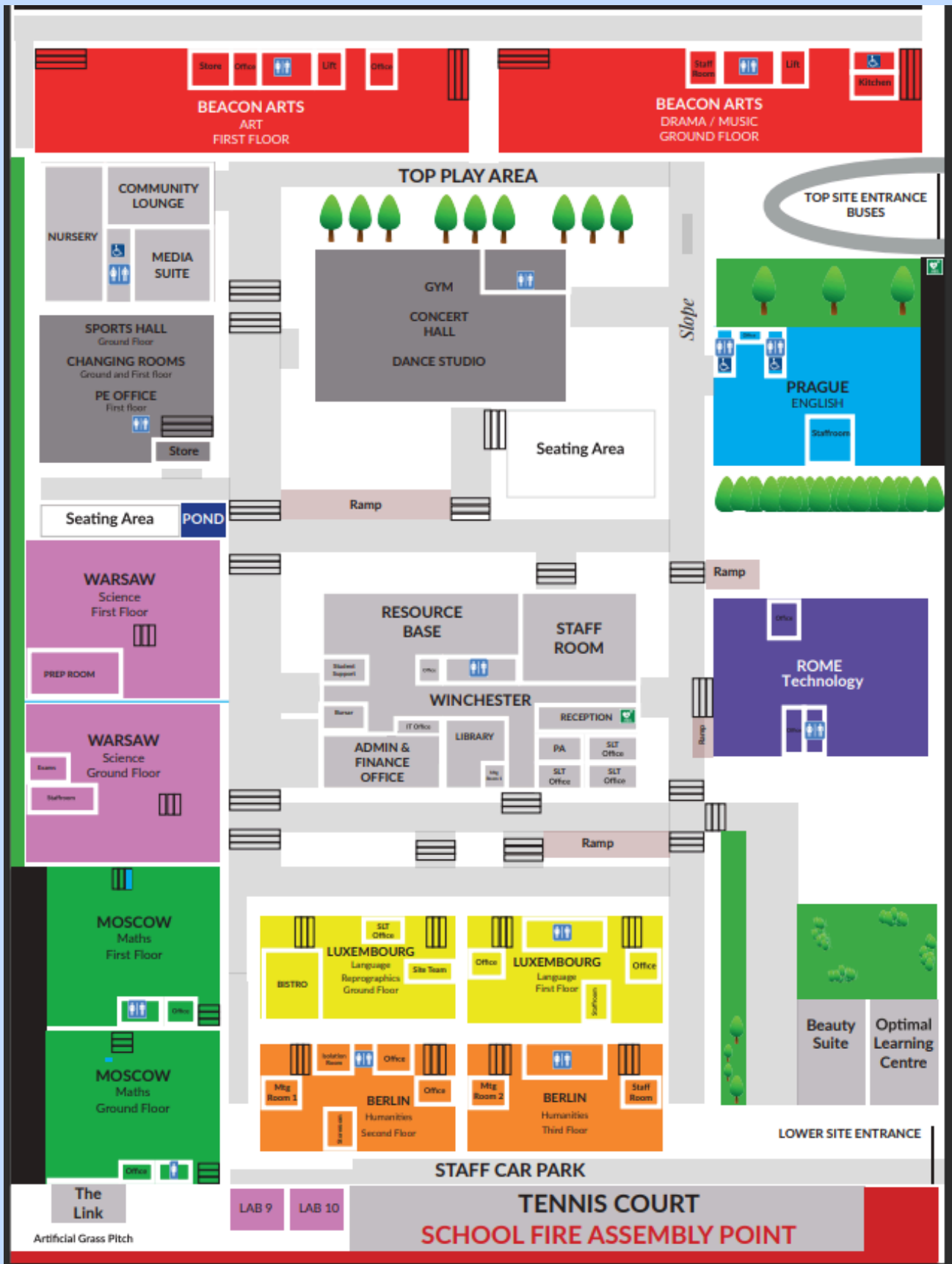


I will go on a tour of the school with my group.

I will wear my normal primary school uniform

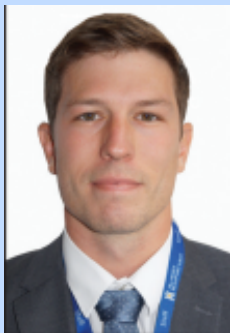


I will go to the play courts for 9am



I will give my name to a teacher who will tell me which group I am in.

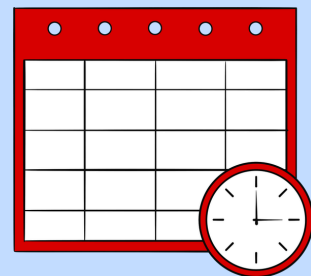
This is my Tutor Group!



I will go to an assembly with my new head of year called Mr Naisbitt.

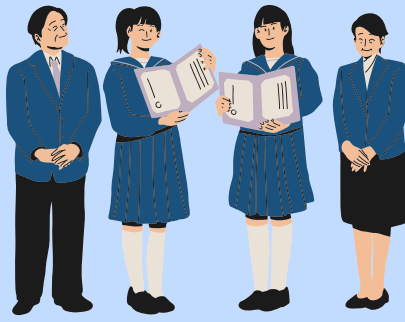


I will line up in my tutor group.



After, I will go to my tutor room.

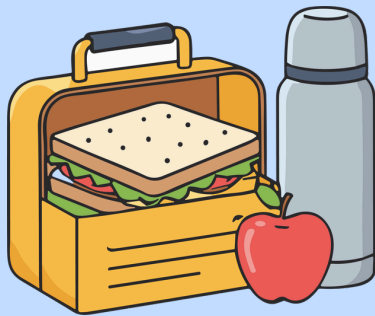
My tutor will give me my timetable for the day



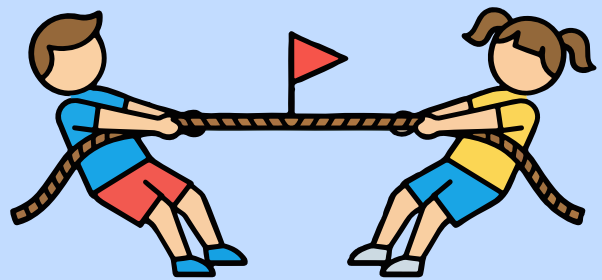
I will have some Student Leaders in my Group. They are older students who will help my group find our way round.



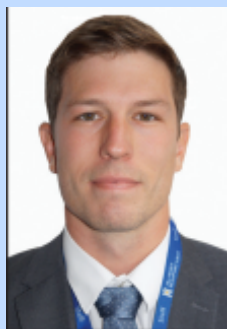
I will try out some different lessons

At the end of the day I will have another assembly to talk about the day

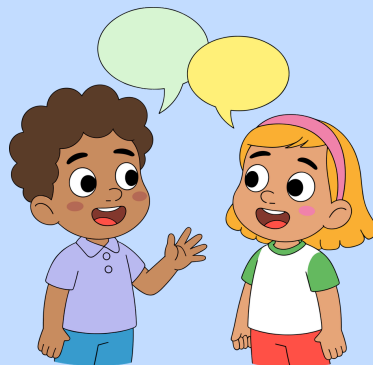


Home time is 2.30!

Today, only year 7s and student leaders will be in school

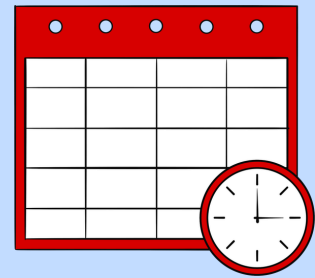


This day will be similar to the transition day! I will have some different lessons.



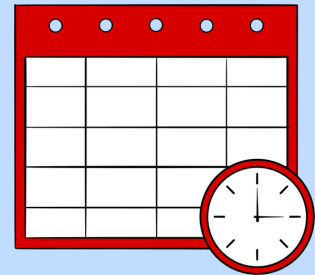
At lunch time there are lots of places I can go.

I will be shown how to use the bistro.

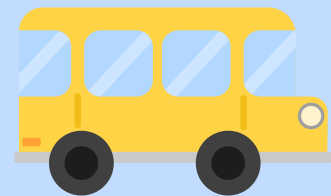


My tutor will give me a timetable for today.
